- Any other agency 3rd party systems or spreadsheets used to track inventory will also be replaced.

The Procurement module will go live on July 1, 2021.

What differences can I expect?



Locations

Agencies can designate locations where goods or services will be accepted in Luma and then track all items in their inventory using subinventory locations.

Quality Assurance

Receivers will have the ability to

inspect items for quality before

accepting them into inventory. This

will allow for quality assurance in all

items received, reducing the hassle of

returning inadequate items when they

are discovered later.



Item Management

Luma users will have greater visibility of item locations which helps to improve purchasing models and strategic sources of goods and services. Long term, this can contribute to the reduction of costs.



Receipt Holds

Receivers will be able to put a receipt on hold in Luma until an inspection of a good is completed, preventing duplicate or early payments. This new functionality will provide clear communications and tracking for receivers.



Lot Numbers

Logistic Supervisors will have the ability to verify items are the correct and expected items when received using lot numbers.



Item Returns

Buyers will have the ability to process items in Luma to show that they are being returned and see comments regarding the return.
